

## Sixth Grade B.E.A.T. Summer Reading

### Project for Incoming 6th grade Students:

After reading *Bud, Not Buddy* and *Flipped*, create a scrapbook for each novel using Microsoft Word, PowerPoint or Google Slides.

Your scrapbook should show that you read and demonstrated below:

- Creative Design
- **Cover page for each novel** including title, author of the work, and student name
- A minimum of **ten one-page** journal entries (**front only**)
- Each scrapbook entry should be labeled with the date, number of the entry, and a title.
- Each scrapbook entry should include writing of some sort depending on the format of the entry. Be sure to use proper grammar, capitalization, punctuation and spelling.
- Journal entries can use a variety of forms such as the following, but **you may not use the format more than once per novel**:
  - Letters to the author detailing favorite parts and asking probing questions.
  - Letters written in the voices of characters to each other during various difficult times throughout the novel.
  - Postcards from settings in the work (front and back).
  - Write poem inspired by the reading.
  - Personal responses to characters and events in the novel – how you feel and why.
  - Research a topic related to the story. Report your findings and cite two online sources.
  - Cartoons or sketches of scenes, characters, and events in the novel with accompanying descriptions.
  - Rewritten scenes, incidents, or endings (imagine if).
  - Plot diagram
  - A Facebook or Instagram profile for a character.
  - A character's playlist with an explanation for each song.
  - Create a ten question multiple-choice quiz about the book with an answer key.
  - Short summary

Your scrapbook is due to your Language Arts teacher the second week of school (no exceptions). It will count as 2 project grades and will be evaluated on effort and completion of the above requirements. **Do not wait until August to begin!**
